

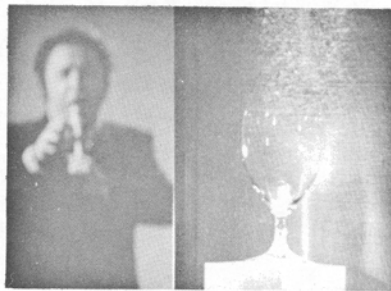
1. (Anncr VO) Can the human voice shatter this glass?



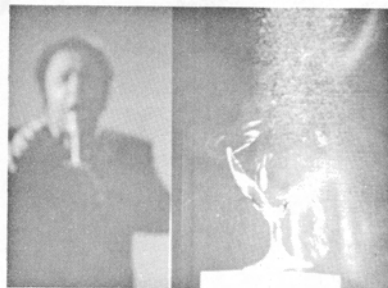
2. (Sfx: singing) We're amplifying the voice of Metropolitan Opera tenor, Enrico Di Giuseppe as he attempts to...

4. (Sfx: singing)



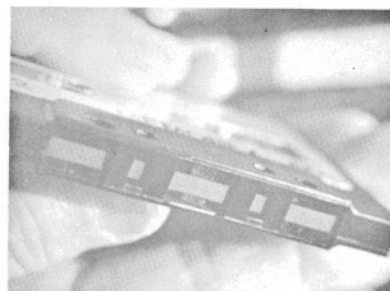
5. (Glass shatters--singing stops) He did it.

7. ... on this... new Memorex Cassette Recording Tape.



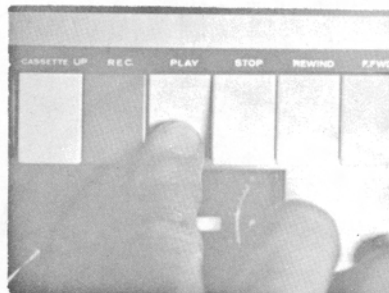
8. Our new Memorex Cassette tape can capture and play back...



9. ... the same pitch, the same fine harmonics,...



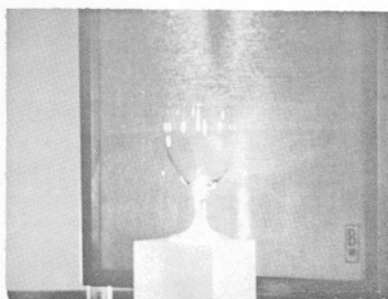
10. ... the same spectrum of sound that shattered glass.



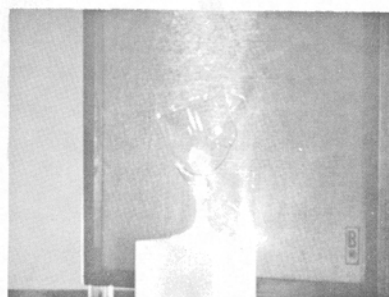
11. (Sfx: click of "play" button. Singing starts) Listen again...
