Holiday Safety

Unfortunately, along with the approach of the holiday season, come predictions of record-breaking highway death tolls. The reasons are readily apparent—more hours of darkness, poor visibility and slippery streets due to rainy weather, holiday rush and activity, fatigue, and more chance of intoxication among both drivers and pedestrians. This year, please heed the warnings of the National Safety Council. Use your seat belts; allow plenty of time to get where you're going; keep a wary eye on the actions of other drivers and pedestrians; be patient and courteous. An accident which injures or kills someone could turn the Christmas season into a time of grief and suffering.

Please remember, too, that the home can be as dangerous as the highway unless you are aware of potential fire hazards. Note that

modern Christmas decorations can also introduce new safety hazards. Be cautious about buying imported lighting sets lacking UL (Underwriters' Laboratories, Inc.) labels; some foreign tree light bulbs have shown imperfections which can cause them to shatter and expose the hot filament. Do not use "angel hair" and snow spray together. Both are advertised as nonflammable, and this is true when used alone. When combined, however, (on your Christmas tree for example) they become extremely combustible. If you use a metallic tree, do not put lights on it. Instead, use spot lights above or at the side. Bubbling lights contain methylene chloride which is poisonous if swallowed. Be alert for safety hazards in your other decorations, too.

Keep your Christmas merry this year by keeping your family accident-free.

Discount on Memorex's Consumer Products

Starting December 15th, employees will have the opportunity to purchase Memorex consumer products at a discount.

Every twelve months, each Memorex employee will be eligible to receive twelve 50¢ discount coupons. One coupon may be used for each Memorex cassette or reel purchased at any retail store; the coupon entitles an employee to 50¢ off the purchase price.
