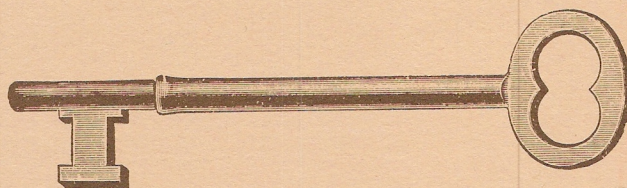


## President- Employee Meetings This Week

Six places are open on the 12-man Board. The six members who will remain through 1971 are:

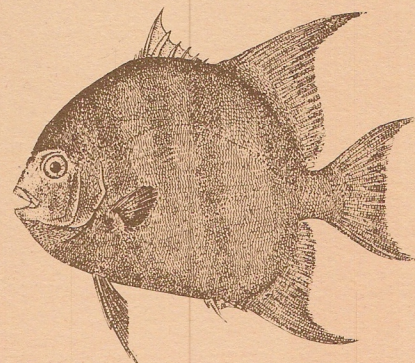
